EMERGENCY MEETING MINUTES

Mayor Canterbury called the Special Meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Tom Canterbury, Recorder Dana Walters, Council Members Tennis Adkins, Carl Harshbarger, Dakota Miller, Troy Nicely and Debbie Conard.

Council Member Miller moved to go into Executive Session at 4:02 pm to discuss personnel issues. Second by Council Member Adkins. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury called the meeting back into session at 4:36 pm. Mayor Canterbury stated that no business was conducted.

Mayor Canterbury brought to the Council's attention some concerns expressed to him about the new proposed design of the Milton floodwall. Area business owners Bob Fannin and Kathy Carter were present. The concerns discussed included the elimination of any future economic growth based on the footprint of an earthen levee and the proposed ponding areas which consume most of the potentially developable areas. It was discussed that the proposed design seems to favor the areas outside of the wall (Georgia Avenue and Pumpkin Park) over the areas inside the wall, but that the City would be responsible for all operation and maintenance costs. Mayor Canterbury suggested that the City prepare comments to be provided to the US Army Corps of Engineers regarding the City's position on these issues. So moved by Council Member Nicely. Second by Council Member Harshbarger. Motion carried.

Council Member Harshbarger moved to adjourn at 5:02 pm. Second by Council Member Miller. Motion carried.
