**SPECIAL MEETING
MINUTES**

Mayor Canterbury called the Special Meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Present were Mayor Tom Canterbury, Recorder Dana Walters, Council Members Tennis Adkins and Dakota Miller. Council Members Carl Harshbarger and Troy Nicely attended via telephone. Council Member Bob Legg was absent.

Council discussed a proposal to change a portion of Pike Street to one-way traffic. Having had an opportunity consider this proposal, a roll-call vote was taken on a Resolution to convert Pike Street to north-bound one-way traffic from Main Street to Church Street, with the votes as follows:

The Resolution to convert Pike Street to north-bound one-way traffic from Main Street to Church Street failed with two (2) members moving in favor of the change and three (3) members moving against the change. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury read a Resolution to transfer \$40,399.70 from the Police Savings account to the General Fund account to reimburse for payment of invoices for technology purchased pursuant to COPS and Chaney Foundation grants. Council Member Miller moved to approve the Resolution. Second by Recorder Walters. Motion carried.

Council Member Miller moved to adjourn at 10:17am. Second by Council Member Adkins. Motion carried.
