

DECEMBER 7, 2021

7:00 P.M.

Mayor Canterbury called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The invocation was given by Council Member Adkins and the pledge of allegiance was said in unison. Those present were Mayor Tom Canterbury, Recorder Dana Walters, Council Members Tennis Adkins, Bob Legg, Carl Harshbarger, Dakota Miller and Troy Nicely.

Council Member Harshbarger moved to approve the agenda. Second by Council Member Miller. Motion carried.

Recorder Walters read the minutes from the October 29 Work Session, the November 2 Regular Meeting, the December 2 Special Meeting, and the December 3 Work Session. Council Member Adkins moved to approve the minutes. Second by Council Member Miller. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury presented the City bills for September 2021 totaling \$168,728.16. Council Member Miller moved to approve the bills. Second by Council Member Harshbarger. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury read the City Financial Report for October 2021. General Fund Total: \$1,242,059.60; Cemetery Total: \$71,386.80; Coal Severance Total: \$12,870.76; American Rescue Plan Act Total: \$559,521.38. Council Member Harshbarger moved to approve the Financial Reports. Second by Council Member Adkins. Motion carried.

Lieutenant Kyle O'Dell read the Police Report for October 2021. Council Member Legg moved to approve the October report. Second by Council Member Adkins. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury read an Amended Resolution for the payment of invoices for the 2018 Sewer Project. Council Member Harshbarger moved to approve the Resolution. Second by Council Member Miller. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury read a Resolution authorizing the transfer of \$26,100.00 from the General Savings account to the Street Construction account to pay Myers Paving for paving on Stewart Street, Parkview Drive and additional patching. Council Member Miller moved to approve the Resolution. Second by Council Member Adkins. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury read a Resolution authorizing the Recorder to close the existing Street Paving Savings Account and open a new Street Construction Checking Account with Ohio Valley Bank. Council Member Miller moved to approve the Resolution. Second by Council Member Adkins. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury read a Resolution supporting participation in the 2022 Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant Program. Council Member Nicely moved to approve the Resolution. Second by Council Member Miller. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury tabled until the January 2022 regular council meeting the reading of a Resolution to prohibit on-street parking on Florida Street from Smith Street to Glenwood Road. Resident T. Maul spoke against the Resolution prohibiting parking on this section of Florida Street and stated the residents needed to know about these matters beforehand, see attachment. Resident T. Simmons spoke about the struggles her family has faced since the prohibition of parking on Mason Street.

Mayor Canterbury gave the First Reading of an Ordinance to Approve the 2021 Codified Ordinances of the City of Milton; to Adopt New Matter; and to Amend and Repeal Certain Obsolete and Conflicting Legislative Provision. Council Member Miller moved to approve the First Reading. Second by Council Member Harshbarger. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury gave the First Reading of an Ordinance of the City of Milton Amending, Modifying and Reenacting Article 932 “Stormwater Management and Surface Water Discharge Control” of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Milton to Include §932.35 “Violation Penalties.” Council Member Adkins moved to approve the First Reading. Second by Council Member Miller. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury gave the First Reading of an Ordinance of the City of Milton Amending, Modifying and Reenacting Article 343.03 “Stopping for School Bus.” Council member Harshbarger moved to approve the First Reading. Second by Council Member Adkins. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury gave the First Reading of an Ordinance of the City of Milton Amending, Modifying and Reenacting Article 333 “Reckless Driving; Hazardous Driving.” Council Member Adkins moved to approve the First Reading. Second by Council Member Miller. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury requested Counsel’s pleasure on the issuance of 2021 merit increases. Council Member Legg moved to issue merit increases the same as last year. Second by Council Member Harshbarger. Motion carried.

Council Member Miller stated that he has not been given any information from the Milton Volunteer Fire Department for some time now, and because of this, he will no longer provide Reports from the Fire Department.

Council Member Harshbarger moved to adjourn at 7:41 pm. Second by Council Member Miller. Motion carried.
