## SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

Mayor Canterbury called the Special Meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. at Pike Street and North Main Street in Milton. Present were Mayor Tom Canterbury, Recorder Dana Walters, Council Members Carl Harshbarger, Tennis Adkins, Dakota Miller and Troy Nicely.

Council discussed a previous proposal to change a portion of Pike Street to one-way traffic and to add additional angled parking. Chief Parsons discussed his findings following an assessment of the area. Council was given an opportunity to examine the space, comment on this proposal, and make suggestions for other ways to increase the number of parking spaces in Milton. No business was conducted pertaining to this matter.

A Resolution of Council for the first budget revision of Fund 2 (Coal Severance) was read. Council Member Carl Harshbarger moved to approve the Resolution. Second by Council Member Miller. A roll call vote was taken with all voting in favor of the Resolution. Motion carried.

A seat on Milton City Council was left vacant upon the death of City Council Member Bob Legg. Mayor Canterbury indicated that the 2021 Municipal Election results showed Deborah Conard as having received the next highest number of votes in the election of Council Members, and he felt that was the most fair method of appointing someone to fill the vacancy. Recorder Walters advised that Scott Bias also voiced his interest in filling the vacancy.

Mayor Canterbury recommended that Deborah Conard be appointed as Council Member to fill the vacant seat on City Council. Council Member Miller moved to approve the appointment of Deborah Conard to fill the vacant City Council Seat. Second by Tennis Adkins. A roll call vote was taken with all voting in favor of appointing Deborah Conard as City Council Member. Motion carried.

Council Member Adkins moved to adjourn at 4:16 pm. Second by Council Member Miller. Motion carried.
