COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

SEPTEMBER 1, 2020

7:00 P.M.

Mayor Canterbury called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The invocation was given by Council Member Adkins and the pledge of allegiance was said in unison. All were present.

Council Member Harshbarger moved to approve the agenda. Second by Council Member Taylor. Motion carried.

Recorder Ryalls read the minutes from the August 4, 2020 meeting. Council Member Miller moved to approve the minutes. Second by Council Member Adkins. Motion carried.

Recorder Ryalls presented the City bills for July totaling \$303,636.01 for the General Fund which are posted in the lobby. Council Member Miller moved to approve the bills. Second by Council Member Legg. Motion carried.

Recorder Ryalls read the City Financial Report for July. General Fund Income: \$424,677.51, Expenses: \$274,468.65 Net: \$150,208.86; Checking: \$66,631.95, Rainy Day: \$431,283.74, Miscellaneous Accounts: \$429,009.57, Total: \$926,925.26; Cemetery Income: \$1,905.65, Expenses: \$40.34, Net: \$1,865.31; Checking: \$4,831.37, Savings: \$63,596.98, CDs: \$33,409.78, Total: \$101,838.13; Coal Severance Income: \$1,057.74, Expenses: \$2,500.00, Net: \$-1,442.26, Total: \$10,939.75. Council Member Harshbarger moved to approve the Financial Reports. Second by Council Member Adkins. Motion carried.

Recorder Ryalls read the City Financial Report for Fiscal Year Ending 2020. General Fund Income: \$3,062,716.27, Expenses: \$3,040,453.67, Net: \$22,262.60; Checking: \$6,714.28, Rainy Day: \$426,228.34, Miscellaneous Accounts: \$570,412.23, Total: \$1,003,354.85; Cemetery Income: \$8,879.86, Expenses: \$11,294.01, Net: \$-2,414.15; Checking: \$4,871.71, Savings: \$61,691.33, CDs: \$33,409.78, Total: \$99,972.82; Coal Severance Income: \$7,565.16, Expenses: \$4,800.00, Net: \$2,765.16, Total:

\$12,382.01. Council Member Miller moved to approve the Financial Reports. Second by Council Member Adkins. Motion carried.

Chief Parsons read the Police Report for July 2020. He advised that he ordered two 2021 Dodge Chargers from Stephens Auto Center for the Police Department and anticipates their receipt in December or January. Recorder Ryalls moved to approve the report for July. Second by Council Member Taylor. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury read a Sewer Project Draw Resolution (Draw 15) for the payment of invoices in the amount of \$626.00 from the Account Titled 2018 Sewer Project. Council Member Miller moved to approve the Resolution. Second by Recorder Ryalls. Motion carried.

Mayor Canterbury read a Resolution of Council to authorize the transfer of funds in the amount of \$36,950.00 from the General Savings Account to the General Fund Account for payment to Myers Paving for paving on Sunset View, Spring Street and Rear Florida Street. Council Member Harshbarger moved to approve the Resolution. Second by Recorder Ryalls. Motion carried.



Mayor Canterbury appointed Benita Ryalls, Cameron Ernst and Susan Elliott to the Audit Procurement Committee. Council Member Harshbarger moved to approve the appointments to the Audit Procurement Committee. Second by Council Member Taylor. Motion carried.

Council Member Miller presented the Milton Fire Department Report for July. They responded to 40 calls that month.

Chief Parsons asked Patrolmen Newcome and Scarberry to come forward. He read an Order promoting each to the rank of Sergeant effective September 3, 2020. Sergeant Scarberry will be the Midnight Shift Supervisor, and Sergeant Newcome will be the Evening Shift Supervisor. Chief Parsons commended both on their performance and ability. Council Member Harshbarger moved to approve the promotions. Second by Council Member Taylor. Motion carried.

Council Member Harshbarger moved to adjourn at 7:40 p.m. Second by Council Member Taylor. Motion carried.
