SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

Mayor Canterbury called the Special Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Present were Mayor Tom Canterbury, Recorder Dana Walters, Council Members Tennis Adkins, Dakota Miller and Deborah Conard. Council Members Carl Harshbarger and Troy Nicely attended via telephone.

A Resolution of Council for the first budget revision of Fund 1 (General Fund) to roll over the remaining balance from fiscal year 2024 to fiscal year 2025 was presented. Council Member Miller moved to approve the first budget revision of Fund 1. Second by Council Member Harshbarger. A roll-call vote was taken with all voting in favor of the first budget revision. Motion carried.

A Resolution of Council for the first budget revision of Fund 2 (Coal Severance) to roll over the remaining balance from fiscal year 2024 to fiscal year 2025 was presented. Council Member Adkins moved to approve the first budget revision of Fund 2. Second by Council Member Conard. A roll-call vote was taken with all voting in favor of the first budget revision. Motion carried.

Council discussed rescheduling the Independence Day Celebration (which was canceled due to weather) to September 14, 2024.

Council Member Harshbarger inquired if the City could name a bridge or roadway after Major General G. Wesley Clark. Mayor Canterbury advised that the renaming of roads and bridges must go through the State Legislature and the Division of Highways.

Council Member Adkins moved to adjourn at 9:21 am. Second by Council Member Miller. Motion carried.
